Dear Doug,

It has recently been brought to our attention that the Avianca Colombia Pilots, as represented by the Asociación Colombiana de Aviadores Civiles (ACDAC, Colombia ALPA), have been actively engaged in negotiations with Avianca management. The parties are unable to resolve their differences, therefore, the ACDAC has announced their intentions to strike on September 20, 2017. It is a lawful strike and the United MEC is fully supporting them in their efforts to reach a fair agreement.

Should the ACDAC engage in such strike, we request that United refrain from entering into any agreement with Avianca that adds capacity or operates as a wet lease during their strike. Additionally, consistent with our history, we request that United cooperate in assisting the stranded Avianca crewmembers with their return home during this dispute.
